CAMP DETAILED DESCRIPTIONS

CRAFT-N-BAKE (k-2nd, 3rd-5th grouping)

In this exciting camp for ages 5 & up, directed by Jessica Welch @ Joanna Moody, 2 projects consisting of a meal and dessert will be created each day. Kitchen safety, nutrition/food pyramid discussion and baking etiquette will be addressed during this camp week. Some of the recipes will involve smoothies, trail mixes, salad dishes, chip dips, cake pops, edible play dough, and other yummy desserts and baked meals. We will also do a drawing or craft each day with a food/household theme (decorated spatulas, vases, paper cake designs etc)! Camp is limited to 10 participants for each age group. Snack is provided. labeled water bottle/sippy cup and a Tupperware container big enough to fit a sandwich.

ALL SEWN UP I & II (favorite projects will repeat, new projects added)

All Sewn Up, with Elizabeth Cascio! She's been sewing for 7 years and started her own company (www.emmemadison.net) making bags out of ribbons. She loves sewing and making creations! Your children will be introduced to sewing on day 1! Project days 2-5 will include making a small pillow with the letter of their first name on it, apron making, simple purses, skirts and vinyl & paper zipper wallets. Your children will find it is "sew" easy and fun! Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack and lunch. Camp is limited to 8 participants. Staff to student ratio is 1:4.

CREATE-A-CAKE I & II (favorite projects will repeat, new projects added)

Taught by the amazing Mariska! Spend a day baking a mini-cake and making the fondant. Then the next day doing the decorating and eating! The kids would come up with their theme and do some sketching of the finished product. All supplies are included in class cost which include all ingredients - marshmallows, powder sugar, food coloring, flavored extracts, vegetable shortening, cake mixes, eggs, and canola oil. For children already attending a camp this week these weeks can flow seamlessly into this workshop.

GREATEST HITS OF ART

In this camp directed by Jessica Welch, children entering kindergarten & up will get to experience almost 20 years of her favorite camp projects! Canvas Painting (Mon/Wed), Crayon Making (Mon/Tues), Tie Dye (Fri), Paper Weaving (Fri), Mosaic Tiling (Tues/Thurs). 2 Projects daily: One drawing lesson and one artsy-fartsy project – all of which you will want to hold onto forever! Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack and lunch. Camp is limited to 20 participants. Staff to student ratio is 1:7

Character creation, script writing, musical composition, set and costume design will be 100% student powered, gently directed by staff members. Daily schedule includes: creative writing/character development, snack, recess, song development, lunch, set design/costumes/art element, theater rehearsal/production. Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack and lunch. Camp is limited to 20 participants. Staff to student ratio is 1:10

PIRATE MUSICAL

Pirates! - From Hal Leonard - The Musical - by John Jacobson and Roger Emerson – A full scale musical directed by our own Joanna Moody! "We're off to sail the rollicking sea, pirates all are we!" But... ARRRR, and shiver me timbers! There's a stowaway on board! Perhaps the King of the High "C's" will know what to do. Join this salty crew of colorful scallywags when Bluebeard, Yellowbeard, Whitebeard, Purplebeard (well, you get the picture), along with the No Beards, hoist the Jolly Roger and set sail for a mighty adventure. We will study art & paintings of all cultures and time periods, do some drawing lessons, plan, paint and party! MWF children will complete at least 2 works of art on canvas. Full week children will have at least 3 paintings. Sizes of canvases vary from the very small 6x6" up to 15x30" – smocks are required! Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack and lunch. Camp is limited to 20 participants. Staff to student ration is 1:7

PREK THEME CAMPS

Super Hero Adventure: Your week will be filled with heroic adventures and games as you meet new friends and leaves happy and exhausted. Weather they are playing super hero cosmic ball, or force field tag, our goal is having fun. Every day there will be super outside games, inside activities, art projects (masks, capes, murals), and reenactments based on the stories of that day. There will be costume dress up, show and tell, sports day, and a water day. An excellent way to ease your child into a social setting and so much fun. Please bring a snack. Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack and lunch. Camp is limited to 8 participants. Staff to student ratio is 1:4.

Fairy Tales and Dragon Tails Cast a magic spell on dragons, run through the enchanted fairy forest, and meet some magical creatures. Each day after reading and creating their own fairy tale, they will play outside games, inside activities, and art projects (wands, fairies, cup cake castles). There will be costume dress up, show and tell, water day, and a mini performance on Friday (which is the cutest thing in the world). An excellent way to ease your child into a social setting and so much fun. Please bring a labeled water bottle, snack and lunch. Camp is limited to 8 participants. Staff to student ratio is 1:4.

Silly Scientists Discovery's Dig for dinosaurs, discover new colors mixing paint, and make erupting volcanoes in this fun engaging camp exploring the world. From tin foil astronauts, real worm races, and creating the best blanket tent ever, your child will love the guided imagination creations. Each day they will be outside adventures, inside experiments and art activities, and an edible creation (no peanuts). There will be get to know you games, singing, indoor/out door physical games, art, costume dress up, show and tell, water day, and mini demonstration on Friday. PHOTO GENIUS CAMP

Tired of your kid taking pictures and cutting your head off or pushing the button and moving the entire camera? This 9am-1pm MWF or a full week camp, designed for young photographers, is a fun and creative way to introduce students to digital photography. This class features photo scavenger hunts and hands-on instruction. Class will culminate into a slide show on Friday @ 12:30, of the campers best work! Camera settings, portraits, close up, land scapes, special affects, composition, computer photo enhancement. Supplies each camper needs: 1 digital camera of any decent quality (none of the kid version cameras as the quality is very poor no matter what you do) + the appropriate USB cord for downloading. Camp is limited to 10 participants. Staff to student ratio is 1:5.

RADICAL REPTILES & ANIMALS CAMP

Directed by John Taibe of Radical Reptiles & Animals and Art 4 Children owner Jessica Welch, children ages 5 & up will participate in Weird Science projects (greenhouse, plants, magnets, volcanoes, super snow, ice cream, pinch n mix colors, colored slime, charcoal crystals and dry ice to name quite a few!) He will also do a reptile and animal presentation. An art lesson from an Art 4 Children art teacher an end of the day outdoor sport will be included!

DRAWING ANIMALS

Taught by Art 4 Children owner Jessica Welch, your 7-10 year old can enjoy a fun drawing animals class M-Th from 130-230. Do all or one day! IF they are attending the other camps offered this week (Go Fish Musical or Radical Reptiles), they can have 30 minutes of free extended care and flow seamlessly into this drawing workshop we are offering. Children ages 5-10 will explore various medias of coloring with crayons, markers, watercolor and oil pastel with a teacher equipped to teach these varying age levels. Every day Mon-Th will be a new animal to explore!

MOMMY & ME DRAWING WORKSHOP

Join Jessica Welch, Art 4 Children owner and your child ages 4.5-6.5 for a Mommy & Me drawing workshop. Not only will you be drawing with your child, but you will also be absorbing how to apply the same skill and confidence building techniques Jessica uses with this age group. Look at this as a successful step-by-step drawing class for your child and a workshop for you. Big focus on fine motor development, learning how to break down the elements of line and shape and also encouraging children to color properly. We will be using various media to color - markers, crayons, watercolor and oil pastel. A perfect class for a child entering prek, kinder or 1st grade! Sign up for MW, T/TH or all 4 classes for this 1-2pm class.

PIANO & RECORDER WORKSHOPS

All summer long from 6/18-8/10 (nothing that there is no camp the 1st two weeks in July), children can join a recorder or piano class after camp, or they can come JUST for this musical workshop. Recorder will be from 1:30-2:15 & Piano 2:15-3:00 Mon thru Thurs. Children must do at least 2 days a week in any M/W or T/TH combo in order to get the most out of these workshop lessons. The tuition includes piano books &/or recorder book, worksheets and a fancy colored recorder and case. Children who are already partaking in a camp and plan to attend BOTH workshops from 1:30-3:00 back to back can flow seamlessly into "extended child care" until their workshop begins at no additional charge. Children who are attending piano workshop from 2:15-3:00, must account for an additional \$5 in extended care per hour.

Lead by Joanna Moody. Children whom have completed kindergarten and are able to hold and recorder and listen to instruction to play will learn this great small, classic, forward facing, woodwind instrument. They will learn note reading and basic theory as well as learn to play fun and memorable songs you will recognize! The children do earn belts with each song they complete using Discovery Music - Recorder Martial Arts Method, so we require a purchased recorder which we will give them on their 1st day of class.

Piano is also lead by Joanna Moody, this is a modified group piano lesson for children entering kindergarten and all levels. Get a studio quality group lesson for your child at a fraction of the cost all summer. Keyboards, headphones as well as piano song worksheets and books. Packets will be provided for all beginning piano students, but those enrolled in multiple weeks of piano instruction or those who have taken piano lessons in the past should bring their own piano books and they will also be given level-appropriate books which is included in the tuition pricing. Please choose from a variety of tuition options (MW, T/TH, M-Th, 1 week or all weeks!) when you register.
